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## EASY PEASY PENMANSHIP

## Sampler Book

This e-book has pages to print out for penmanship practice. These pages are for young children (four to five years old) who are just starting to learn to write letters. They are for writing the capital letters.

Most of this sampler book is made of pages that have three large boxes to write in. On each page, there is a large dotted letter to trace and a letter to look at and copy into the three boxes.

Pages 4 through 81 have the letters arranged according to difficulty: from simple and straight to curves and slants, with each letter repeated three times (so you can easily print all these pages out at once). Keep in mind that there will be some letters that children will need to have more practice with, so you will need to print more of some of the letter pages, after you see how it is going.

You can assign these pages according to the child's readiness-if making straight lines goes well, but curving lines are too hard, you can just print out the straight line letters and repeat them over and over for a while. Then, slowly introduce some of the curvy letters, but continue to practice the easier ones, too.

Pages 82 through 107 have all the letters in alphabetical order, so you can use this section to find and print out a specific letter (or to do the work pages inalphabetical order).

For an index telling the page number for each letter, see page 82.
This sampler book is part of a larger book called Easy Peasy Penmanship-Capitals. At the end of this sampler book, you will find some examples of the four other types of pages that are part of the entire Easy Peasy Penmanship book.

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# The following pages are samples of some other types of pages that make up the rest of the Easy Peasy Penmanship e-book: 

The next set of pages (21 pages) are for writing four different letters at a time, in circles (still easy, but the child will have to write a little smaller).

Then, there is a set of pages (9 pages) for writing three letters both in circles and on lines (writing on lines is a little more difficult).

Next, there is a set of pages (15 pages) for writing only on lines.

Last, there are pages that have words or phrases to be copied in capital letters; these are to be copied beneath the printed words (there are no boxes, circles, or lines for writing in/on).

There are two sets of these pages: one set has words like "butterfly," "milkshake", etc. which have two parts. The first part of the word is written above the second part. There are 20 of these pages.

The second set has phrases that such as "over the fence", and "at the top" to copy, arranged in a column with three parts. There are 35 of these pages.

These work pages follow a natural progression of writing skill. You can do one page a day, following the pages in order, or can make several copies of some or all of the pages.
